Instructions for downloading GeoJSON files

1. Purpose

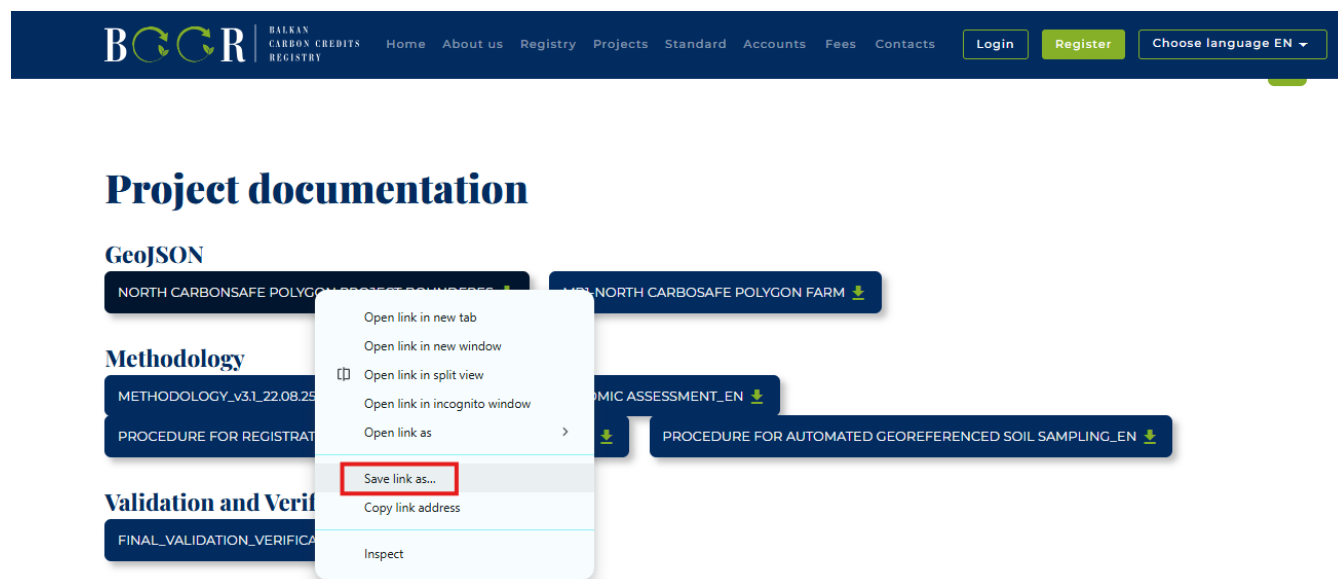
The GeoJSON files published for projects in **the Balkan Carbon Credits Registry (BCCR)** are intended for use in geographic information systems (GIS), such as **QGIS**, **ArcGIS** and other compatible software.

Depending on the web browser used, when you select a GeoJSON file, it may open as a text document rather than being downloaded automatically. In this case, follow the steps described below.

2. Step 1 – Downloading the file

1. Open the project page and locate the **GeoJSON** section.
2. **Right-click** on the desired file.
3. From the context menu, select **'Save link as...'** (or **'Запази връзката като...'** if your browser is set to Bulgarian).

3. Step 2 – Saving the file

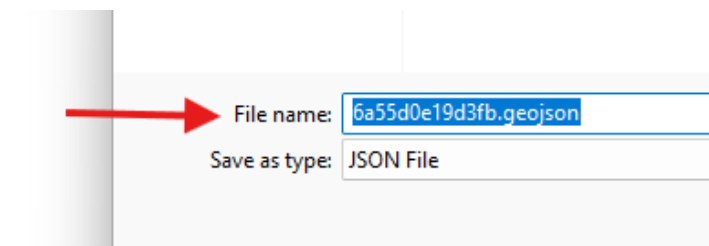
A dialogue box will open, asking you to select a location to save the file. Check the file name. If **the .geojson extension has not been added**, add it manually.

Example:

❌ 6a55d0e19d3fb

✓ 6a55d0e19d3fb.geojson
Then click **Save**.

Figure 2. Check the file name and, if necessary, add the **.geojson** extension.



Note

If, when **you left-click on** the GeoJSON file, it opens as plain text in your web browser, this **does not mean that the file is corrupted**. This is normal behaviour for some browsers when handling files of this type.

In this case, return to the project page and repeat the download by right-clicking and selecting **'Save link as...'**.

An upcoming version of the platform will allow GeoJSON files to be downloaded directly without the need to use the **'Save link as...'** option.
